CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND ROLL CALL. Council President Springer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Mayor's absence. Alderpersons present: Osborn, Quimby, Springer, Griffin, Thomas, Stinnett and Petts. Absent: none. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Thursday March 7th, 2019

On Monday February 11th, 2019 we had our monthly EMS training. Training was in three stations. The first station was on OB birth and complications. The members went through a normal birth with our manikins that we have for that training and then reviewed all the complications that could go wrong and now what to do for those patients. The second station was on infant CPR and infant vital signs. We had a member's child and another member's infant come down so our members could take vitals and interact with the kids. Then we practiced infant CPR and everything to look at the scene. The third station was on pediatric trauma with landing zone operations and radio communications. For this station our members went out to one of our officer's houses and his child was the patient. The scenario was child fell from a 10 ft height. The members needed to complete their assessment and decide what other resources were needed. For instance Med Flight and then the members had to communicate with fire members and Med Flight.

On Monday February 18th, 2019 we had our monthly Fire training. Training was in two stations. The first station was on mask up drills. The member is in full turnout gear and SCBA and about to make entry into a structure but they have to mask up at the door. The member has to put their mask on with gloves in less then 30 seconds and breathing air. The second station was hose advancement. This is when the members exit the apparatus, grab the hose and lays the hose a certain way so there is no kinks and is ready to be advanced in the structure. This has to be done with in 30 seconds from when the apparatus stops.
