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ESSENTIAL ADDENDUM TO PLUMBER / PROPERTY OWNER CONTRACT

Before performing any work, both Property Owner and Plumber must complete and sign this form.
The property owner and plumber shall contract directly for the lead water service line replacement, but the City of Waterloo will make direct reimbursement to the property owner in one of the following amounts -- as described in the property owner application:

- Up to \$950 for an Option #2 Grant
- Up to \$2,200 for an Option #3 Grant/Loan
- Up to \$2,000 for an Option #4 Grant/Young Child

The form below is an addendum to the agreement between the property owner and plumber, and lists the conditions of the municipal reimbursement.

1. Property owner has entered into a contract with Plumber for replacement of the lead water service line at owners' property.
2. A copy of at least one bid is attached to this addendum.
3. The City of Waterloo has approved the replacement of Property owners' Lead Water Service Line application.
4. The replacement of Property owners' lead water service line is subject to the City of Waterloo Building Inspector, or his representative, inspecting and certifying that the replacement of the lead water service line is complete and was done in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations. A standard permit (\$60 fee) is required. To expedite the permitting process, contact Chris Butschke (608) 576-6371. The new inspection request line is: 608-688-0997.
5. An itemized invoice marked as paid by the Plumber shall be included with a reimbursement request by the property owner. The City of Waterloo agrees to reimburse the property owner the lesser of the approved funding option; or the contract amount, within 30 days after the City

receives notification that the certification described above was obtained and payment has been made in full to the plumber.

6. The Property owner understands that the maximum amount the City of Waterloo will pay for line replacement is based on the option selected and the approved award amount. Any amount the Plumber charges beyond that amount is the responsibility of the Property owners and not the City of Waterloo.
7. The Property owner understands and agree that the Property owner is solely responsible for the selection of the Plumber and has contracted with the Plumber for the replacement of the Property owners' lead water service line independently from the City of Waterloo. Accordingly, in consideration for the amount paid by the City of Waterloo, the Property owners agree to release the City of Waterloo, and its employees and officials, from any loss, damage or unexpected costs or expenses arising from replacement of Property owners' lead water service line.
8. The City of Waterloo reserves the right to deny reimbursement for failing to comply with applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations.
