

## What documents can I use to prove that I am a Wisconsin/Waterloo Resident?

If this is your first time registering to vote in Wisconsin, you will need to have one of the following forms of proof of residence:

- A current and valid Wisconsin driver's license or Wisconsin identification card.
- Any other official identification card or license issued by a Wisconsin governmental body or unit
- An identification card issued by an employer in the normal course of business, which has a photograph of the cardholder, but not a business card.
- A real estate tax bill or receipt for the current year or the year preceding the date of the election.
- A UW-Madison or Edgewood College ID card with a photograph of the cardholder, if student is listed on certified housing list.
- A utility bill for the period commencing not earlier than 90 days before the election.
- A bank statement.
- A paycheck.
- A check or other document issued by a unit of government.

The State of Wisconsin requires an original signature on your voter registration form. If you submit a voter registration form and copy of document from above list via fax or e-mail, you still need to mail the original form to the City Clerk's Office.
