Water Resources: Abundant Supply, Low Cost, High Quality

Founded on the banks of the Mauneshia River, Waterloo has long attracted companies which recognize the benefits of abundant and high quality water resources. Regional and national companies in a wide variety of industries including dairy, food processing, rubber molding and plastics manufacturing take advantage of reliable and low cost water availability provided by the community-owned Waterloo Utilities. Specific benefits for high water use industries of a Waterloo location include:

- **Abundant supply** – 1 million gallon storage, excess pumping capacity of 1.2 million gallons per day
- **Low cost** - \$2.17 per 1,000 gallons for high volume users
- **Reliable service** and high quality infrastructure with 58 psi pressure
- **Community owned** utility with personal service

Of critical importance to businesses, Waterloo Utilities can accommodate large users with reliable and high quality water supply. Waterloo has three ground source wells which provide clean and pure water with moderate hardness.

Water costs in many neighboring communities are higher than those charged in Waterloo. Because community-owned utilities do not operate to make a profit, you pay only for the cost of service. This allows us to provide highly competitive water rates. The following table highlights the cost for water and water treatment customers within the City of Waterloo.

High volume users experience declining rates based on use. Monthly rates for first 8,300 gallons per month are \$2.84 per 1,000 gallons, while rates for each 1,000 gallons beyond 158,400 gallons are \$2.58 per 1,000 gallons, dropping to \$2.17 per 1,000 gallons above 166,700 gallons per month.

Waterloo Utilities has consistently invested in infrastructure and capacity improvements to maintain high quality service. Recent upgrades have included scheduled upgrades to water main sizing and looping of deadends. The industrial park is served with a 12" main to accommodate all types of users.
