



Thursday January 1st, 2016

On Monday December 14th, 2015 we had our monthly EMS training. We went to the new apartments for a tour to see how they are set up and to know the layout. We had three stations. The first station was hypothermia and how to care for those patients. The members have to be very gentle with these patients and also not too warm them to fast. The second station was on respiratory distress. There are so many reasons why someone can have breathing difficulties and the members have to figure out what is causing the problems and give the right treatment to help them. The third station was review of the trucks. This may seem simple but there is a lot of equipment on these ambulances and we make sure our members know where everything is and how and when to use all of the equipment.

On Monday December 21st, 2015 we had our monthly Fire training. We went to the new apartments for a tour to see how they are set up and to know the layout. Also to start preplanning the structure in case of a fire or other emergency. We came up with some scenarios and tried to figure out the best plan for those situations. This is from apparatus placement, water source, ways to attack a fire and so much more. This is why we take tours of buildings in our area to try to be as ready as we can if that situation comes forth. Then we checked over our gear. This is more than looking at the gear and saying yup its good. We need to take it completely apart, the inside liner, the outside and make sure its not worn, cut, soiled and burned. We checked the boots, helmets and masks also. The gear is how we survive in the fire and we need it to be in the best working condition we can.

On Monday December 14th, 2015 we had received a donation from Enbridge. They have a program that gives back to the communities that the pipeline is around. They had discussed this project with Fulltime Firefighter/AEMT Jason Butzine around three years ago and they helped set this up. This was the year we were picked. Enbridge donated a 2008 Chevrolet pickup truck and approximately \$500.00 worth of toys to the Christmas Neighbors Program that we help out with.

On Friday December 18th, 2015 we had 6 of our member's just finish a 60 hour Fire Inspector course. These members will be completing the fire inspections in our district.
