



In view of Administrative Appeal hearing January 3, 2018, regarding Tim Nelson's grievance of December 12, 2017 snowfall, and the conclusion of the Board of Appeal regarding grievance was accepted and the charge of \$95 be dropped.

The conclusion of the Appeal on January 3, 2018, was this was minimal snow evidence and Public Workers should use better judgement in determining a fine.

I would submit the following information regarding a similar sidewalk fine that was made the same day.

**Statement 426: Stating the charge of \$95 for clearing sidewalk
Snow accumulation was less then .6 inches.**

The above charge to The Waterloo Area Historical Society/Museum was paid as the Invoice said "Due 15 days from the Invoice Date" which was Dec. 14, 2017. Due date stated December 29th, 2017. The Invoice was received December 18, 2017, and paid December 20, 2017.

In view of the fact that there was no notice of a citizen's right to Appeal, (in above Statement 426) I feel in view of the fact that another citizen appealed (who knew about the process as he was a former Council Member) the Museum which I represent should be awarded the same courtesy of the January 3, 2018, Appeal Meeting.

I attended the January 3 Appeal Meeting as I do read via internet Council and other City meetings' calendar and minutes of meetings. I voiced my concern over the Public Works Ordinance and its duties, and the Museum charge. I also supported Mr. Nelson's view of using better judgement and looking again at the Ordinance for future modifications. I also used the term "common sense" as this is a small town of est. 3,000 citizens.

As I now look at the Municipal Administrative Procedure included in the Appeal of Mr. Nelson's Appeal process agenda. I believe 68.08 states one has 30 days to "Request for review of determination."

If the decision is NOT refund the \$95 dollar check to the Society. Please accept my written request for an Administrative Appeal regarding 130 E. Polk Street, if it is decided no refund will be made. I believe this request is within the 30 day time limit.


