

CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE & ROLL CALL. Council President Springer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Mayor's absence. Alderpersons present: Osborn, Quimby, Springer, Griffin, Thomas Stinnett and Petts. Absent: none. Others present: Tammy Krueger, Watertown Daily Times; Diane Graff, the Courier; Police Chief Sorenson; Waterloo Utilities Superintendent Sorenson WLOO videographers; Municipal Attorney Hahn; Jason Schoenwetter; Mike Kohls; Terry Sauer; Brent Voelker; Maureen Giese; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Kawula and Clerk/Treasurer Hansen. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Waterloo Residents near Firemen's Park:

RE: NOTICE OF PROPOSED FIREMEN'S PARK CELL TOWER GROUND LEASE

The Waterloo City Council is considering entering into a long-term ground lease with AT&T to allow for the installation and operation of a cellular communications tower in Firemen's Park. This notice is to make you aware of the proposal and to provide background information about the proposal along with information about the public approval process for this proposal.

About the proposed cell tower lease and proposed installation:

- From AT&T representative Daniel Kalina:
 - The tower is to aid in emergency response services and to improve AT&T commercial cell service.
 - Height of tower, 190 feet. AT&T needs to achieve this height to adequately provide service.
 - It will not have a top light, either lighted or blinking. A light will not be required by the FAA and AT&T will not install a light.
 - A quiet generator will be part of the installation. The generator is only for emergency purposes only.
- This project is a source of new recurring municipal revenue. A monthly lease payment of \$790 per month equals \$9,480 per year.
- The lease agreement term under consideration is for five years with five automatic renewal provisions.

About the public approval process:

1. **City Council consideration of a long-term ground lease.**
 - a. The City Council will consider a long-term ground lease agreement on November 15, 2018 at 7 pm in Council Chambers as part of the regularly scheduled City Council meeting.
2. **AT&T's request for a conditional use permit** to construct a proposed.
 - a. If an agreement is concluded, AT&T would follow-up by seeking a conditional use permit. All property owners located within 200 feet of the proposed tower will be notified in advance of a public hearing. The Plan Commission would hold a public hearing in advance of its consideration. It is to make a recommendation to the City Council of either: approval, approval with conditions, or denial.
 - b. The City Council would take up the Plan Commission recommendation at its next regularly scheduled meeting after the Plan Commission recommendation is made.
3. If steps 1 & 2 are affirmatively completed, the final step would be for the **Building Inspector to issue a building permit** in accordance with any conditions placed on the project.

On Monday October 8th, 2018 we had our monthly EMS training. Training consisted of three stations. The first station was on Diabetic with new insulin pumps. There are multiple new styles of insulin pumps and our members need to know what to look for and how they operate. The second station was on drugs. They discussed the types of drugs that are out there that people are using and abusing, the warning signs of drug abuse or overdose and scene safety making sure we do not get harmed on these types of calls. The third station was on what to do and policies and procedures with protocols. Members discussed multiple incidents where policies and procedures comes up and how the protocols will also be part of that incident.

On Monday October 15th, 2018 we had our monthly Fire training. Training consisted of two stations. The first station was on RIT (Rapid Intervention Team) packaging. There are multiple ways of packaging a firefighter to get them out of harm's way if they are injured. The members practiced the ways to get them packaged for removal. The second station was on the FAST board. This board is utilized for RIT to be able to get them on the board quickly and out of harm's way.

On Monday October 29th, 2018 we had our quarterly combination training. Training consisted of search and rescue for a down/lost hunter. DNR allowed our department to utilize the DNR property to complete our training. This is by far the biggest team work effort that the fire department trains on. All members must work as one unit to locate and treat the down/lost hunter. Our members work in teams but not all as one big one at the same time.

WINTER ON-STREET PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION – Municipal Code 350-7(G)

Chapter 350: VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

§ 350-7. Parking restrictions.

- G. Winter parking regulations. No person shall park in any City street or public parking lot in the City between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 15 to April 1, except by permit as set forth in Subsection E or as hereinafter set forth:
- (1) Overnight parking on City streets may be allowed by permit only. The permit fee shall be as stated in the City of Waterloo Fee Schedule for each winter season from November 15 to April 1. Editor's Note: The Fee Schedule is on file at the office of the City Clerk-Treasurer.
 - (2) Permits for winter on-street parking shall be issued only on the basis of unusual need for vehicles owned by City residents residing on property which does not have a driveway, lacks sufficient space to provide for off-street parking and does not have a reasonable alternative for overnight parking.
 - (3) Permit applications are to be obtained, completed and paid for at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer. Applications shall be submitted to the Council for review and granting or denial.
 - (4) The permit shall be displayed as required on the permit whenever a vehicle is parked on the City street overnight from November 15 to April 1. Failure to display the permit, as required, shall result in vehicle parking violations and subject the vehicle to being towed at the expense of the operator/owner.
