Mayor Thompson has appointed Jackson Street resident Natasha Lang to serve on the Waterloo Parks Commission.

Ms. Lang has been a citizen of Waterloo (as an adult) since 2004. She also spent many years here as a child. She is married with two children who are involved with sports offered by the Waterloo Youth Sports Organization.
