

**CITY OF WATERLOO PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MINUTES
COUNCIL CHAMBERS
June 6, 2013**

1. **Roll Call And Call To Order.** Alderperson Springer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Committee members present – Springer, Ziaja and Stinnett. Absent – none. Others present – Mayor Thompson, Gene Weihert, Public Works Director Gary Yerges, Maureen Giese and Clerk/Treasurer Hansen.
2. **Approval Of Previously Unapproved Meeting Minutes.** **Motion:** Moved by Ziaja, seconded by Stinnett to approve the May 2, 2013 meeting minutes as presented. **Voice Vote:** Motion carried.
3. **Citizen Input.** Maureen Giese inquired about what can be done to prevent trains from blowing whistles, and she asked why is the Public Works Department always repainting the yellow curbs that are seemingly always peeling creating an eyesore. Springer replied on trains and Yerges spoke of water-based paint relating to the curbs.
