

**THE DATE FOR CURBSIDE LEAF PICKUP HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO:**

**NOVEMBER 22, 2013**

The Waterloo Public Works Department picks up brush & fallen tree branches the 1st and 3rd Monday of the month from April until October. The last brush pick-up for 2013 will be October 21st. Have your brush and tree limbs to the curb by October 21st. The Public Works Department will pick-up and dispose of Christmas trees, but will not restart the regular wood chipping service until April of 2014.

Also, residents seeking to have tree leaves removed from private property can rake leave into the street along the curbside until November 8th. After that point, you must bag your leaves in a clear plastic bag for pick-up or transport them to the compost site in Firemen's Park.

Remember, you can compost your leaves on your property. It makes a great mulch for plants and shrubs.

Again, the deadline for brush pick-up is October 21st. And you can rake leaves into the street for pick-up until November 8th. Thank you.
