### **Canal Street Resurfacing Project And Riverwalk Redevelopment Project**

September 1, 2016

Canal Street from West Madison Street to the western City Limits (approximately 2,500 feet) will be closed to through traffic beginning Wednesday, September 7 until approximately late October for the reconstruction of underground utilities and street resurfacing. Canal Street construction activities will include water main installation, sanitary sewer installation, pulverizing of the existing asphalt pavement, placement of asphalt pavement and restoration of disturbed areas.

The Riverwalk Redevelopment project will occur outside of the public right-of-way and will not restrict traffic movements. The project entrance is located north of the intersections of West Madison Street and South Harrison and South Jackson Streets. Riverwalk Redevelopment will include the installation of culverts, an asphalt surface multi-use path, access ramp and the removal of an existing bridge deck. This work is also anticipated to be completed late October.

The general contractor for both projects is Woleske Construction Company from Green Bay, Wisconsin. There will also be a number of subcontractors working at various times during the projects.

Motorists are reminded to abide by all traffic control signs and devices as well as be aware of ongoing construction activities. Alternate routes should be planned to avoid construction whenever possible.
