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## Construction Update STH 19 Project – Waterloo, WI for the week of May 8, 2017



### SAFETY 1<sup>st</sup>:

- Please slow down in and around the work zone
- REMINDER: A road construction project makes a very dangerous but attractive playground for children. Please warn them of the dangers and please keep them clear of the construction area.

- **Expect construction traffic entering and leaving the work zone. Trucks will be entering and leaving the closed roadway for work operations.**
- **STH 19 will be closed from Palmer Street to Van Buren Street.**

### **Notices:**

- Garbage pickup will remain on Fridays, however, as construction progresses the contractors may need to coordinate with garbage pickup. Please be sure to get your bins all of the way out to the curb for pickup.
- Work on the reconstruction of STH 19 has begun.
- Residents that have mailboxes in the terraces within the work zone will need to relocate their mailboxes to allow construction crews to complete their work. Please contact the Waterloo Post Office to coordinate temporary relocations during the construction project.

### **Closures**

- Stage 1 traffic pattern will be in effect throughout the project. Both Canal Road and Minnetonka Way will be closed near STH 19.
- Stage 1 of STH 19 will be closed to thru traffic, however, local traffic maintains access to STH 19. Local traffic includes residents along STH 19 as well as business traffic to businesses along STH 19 that do not have alternate access from a side street.
- The Stage 1 Alternate Business Access Route is posted to assist local traffic around the project. The route utilizes Washington St. and McKay Way around the south side of the City as well as Polk and Jackson Streets to access the downtown businesses.
- STH 19 thru traffic will be detoured on STH 89, IH 94, and STH 73 for the duration of the project.

### **Work Operations**

Crews have completed the traffic control and Stage 1 closure of STH 19 as well as the initial erosion control items for Stage 1.

Crews have completed the removal of trees from Canal Street to the closed bridge just west of Van Buren Street. Contractors have installed temporary pedestrian curb ramps and/or crosswalks at Canal Rd. and Minnetonka Way. Pedestrians are advised to stay on the redirected sidewalk.

Crews have removed the existing asphalt surface and broken the existing concrete pavement beneath the existing asphalt.

On Monday May 8<sup>th</sup>, removal of the existing concrete will begin. Removals are scheduled to be completed on May 10<sup>th</sup>. Once pavement removal nears completion, crews will begin installing the new sanitary sewer from the closed bridge and working to the west.
