

Minimal to minor impact to you: Friday, May 2 - Saturday, May 3, 2025

On Saturday, May 3, the Road Race will happen in the City of Waterloo, Town of Medina within Jefferson County, and Dane County. We have support from Jefferson County and Jefferson County Highway departments for use of County HWY O, as well as Town of Medina and City of Waterloo for use Waterloo Road, Vieth Road, Box Elder Road, East Medina Road, Tower Line Road, Cherry Lane, and McKay Way. Additionally, we have the support from the Wisconsin DOT for the use of HWY 19. The race will start and finish at Trek Bicycle Headquarters on McKay Way. A map of the course is below.

Implications to you on Friday, May 2 and Saturday, May 3, 2025

We apologize for any inconvenience caused to you during this race and appreciate your cooperation in allowing the National Championship Road Race to be hosted here. Access to racecourse roads (Waterloo Road, Vieth Road, Box Elder Road, East Medina Road, Tower Line Road, Cherry Lane, and McKay Way, County HWY O and HWY 19) will be limited, especially while the race is happening. We ask that you do not park on the street and that you plan to try and limit use of these roadways during racing time. The roads will be accessible throughout the race day, but closures will happen approximately every 20 minutes will last for a few minutes. We encourage you to use alternate routes during the race and thank you for your patience. Schedule of Events

Setup – Our staff will be setting up race materials (fencing, etc.) on **Friday, May 2, in the PM hours**. These materials will block the usage of McKay Way between HWY 19 and the intersection of McKay Way and Knowlton.

Setup will continue **Saturday, May 3, from 7 – 8:30am**. At this time, roadways will be accessible, but please be aware of our staff and race materials.


Racing will be from 9am – 6pm on Saturday, May 3. Access Waterloo Road, Vieth Road, Box Elder Road, East Medina Road, Tower Line Road, Cherry Lane, and McKay Way, County HWY O and HWY 19 will be closed intermittently throughout the race. These road closures are part of a rolling closure where the roads will only be closed while the race is happening. If you are attempting to drive on a part of the racecourse while the racers are in that section of the course, we ask you please wait a few minutes until the race passes. Police/support vehicles will make it clear that the race is coming and/or has just passed your residence. Before pulling your vehicle onto the racecourse, please ensure the road is clear of police presence. We appreciate your patience and understanding to ensure all athletes and staff are safe! If you have emergent day-of needs, please call 920-545-5592 ext 12692.

Teardown will begin immediately following the conclusion of the race (**around 6pm Saturday, May 3**) with priority set to reopen the roads ASAP. Please be aware of our staff and race materials.




