# 4. Manager's report. (Interim Report by WLOO CATV Board Chair Cotting)

Laura Cotting reviewed station assets and finances, met with Videographers Uhlig and Weihert, and implemented MCW's Blue Care plan. The Good News: Remaining funds in this year's budget will support WLOO baseline operations plus filming a few community events. Both videographers have been maintaining minimum basic duties all September. They agreed to increased average weekly hours starting in October (pending Board approval) which will include filming all Thursday evening committee meetings, short weekly meetings with Cotting, and also special meetings and community events (as the budget permits). Per the Blue Care Plan, MCW remotely accessed the ThinkStation computer and guided Cotting through the Disk Imaging procedure. Images will be stored on the WLOO Shuttle drive. MCW ran a Speed Check on the internet connection, maxdown/maxup speeds were typical residential subscription rate of 400/10 Mbps. The maxup speed is too slow for livestreaming and uploading video files. Spectrum business in the area claims to offer maxup speed of 20 Mbps, and WLOO is paying for business rates... The Bad News: WLOO Office temperatures average in the 90s. Repeated attempts to contact Solarium management to repair the AC have not gotten results. There is little or no training documentation or documentation of any kind. The printer is malfunctioning. There are a few external drives which don't work. There are numerous pieces of obsolete equipment. Neither videographer has been trained in how to livestream action events, such as sports.
